

DRAMA ENVIRONMENT CHECKLIST

Think about the following things when setting up your space for digital drama workshops:

Is the area free of distractions?
Is there excessive noise in the area?
Are there trip or slip hazards in the area?
Does the area have sufficient power points available?
Is the equipment (power cords, computers, tablets etc) in a good, safe, working condition?
Is there a proper place to sit and see the screen of your device?
Is the device set up on a stable surface such as a desk or tripod?
Is the device in landscape mode?
Do you have access to a stable internet connection?
Does your webcam work?
Is there an open space where the young artist can get up and move during the workshop?
Is the young artist wearing comfortable clothing they can move in?
Does the young artist have a water bottle?
