

DRAMA ENVIRONMENT CHECKLIST

Think about the following things when setting up your space for digital drama workshops:

- Is the area free of distractions?
- Is there excessive noise in the area?
- Are there trip or slip hazards in the area?
- Does the area have sufficient power points available?
- Is the equipment (power cords, computers, tablets etc) in a good, safe, working condition?
- Is there a proper place to sit and see the screen of your device?
- Is the device set up on a stable surface such as a desk or tripod?
- Is the device in landscape mode?
- Do you have access to a stable internet connection?
- Does your webcam work?
- Is there an open space where the young artist can get up and move during the workshop?
- Is the young artist wearing comfortable clothing they can move in?
- Does the young artist have a water bottle?
