- 5. Strong organisational skills and the ability to work with minimal supervision.
- 6. A current Working With Vulnerable People clearance.

## Desirable skills and knowledge:

- 7. Performing Arts or Drama Teaching qualifications.
- 8. A current First Aid certificate
